Pursuant to Art. 13, section 1 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (GDPR), we hereby inform that:

- 7) You have a right to access the contents of your personal data, to rectify, remove, limit processing, a right to trasfer your data, object to further processing, or, when your personal data is processed under your consent, to withdraw that consent. Withdrawing the consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to the withdrawal.
- 8) If you believe that the processing of your data breaches the provisions of the GDPR you have a right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
